- 1. Open architecture computer. Made in USA, in fact, Bristol, IN. From a company that has been making voice loggers for almost 30 years!**
- \*The SCL was designed “from the ground up” by experienced logger people. The engineers at RPT evaluated systems from foreign sources such as Eletech, and found their systems lacking in functionality and data protection. No other self contained or “feature attachment” logger has the features and security benefits of the SCL.**
  - \*Friendly telephone technicians that are eager to help and know what service is all about.**
  - \*Factory on-site install engineers available. Or, install the equipment yourself and call your sales representative for a free over the phone training session.**
  - \*Stand alone logging for data protection, and long term legal protection. Store data in a secure place, not on some “server” somewhere. Maintain the SCL in your locked office, especially if your operators take credit card information!**

**Use the Data Bases of Amtelco®, Startel®, Tascom®, Morgan®,**

**CadCom®, Telescan®, Axon® or telephone SMDR (station message detail report), information to locate and play the calls. In fact, any Access 97/2000 data base! And now Startel® telephone equipment users can search by their account number on our voice loggers!**

- 2. The SCL8900 is one (9ch), two (18ch), or three (27ch) ISA cards, software, and the telephone (DAA) interface. THE COMPUTER IS STANDARD! No “special” “proprietary” “factory only” service with the SCL8900. Any computer technician anywhere can service the SCL8900.**
- 3. The SCL Simple Computer Logger has a 1 year depot warranty - then sign up with our maintenance program or your people can take care of the SCL.**
- 4. The SCL can be put on your network and the master computer can be listened to, just like any other network computer, with our Secure Play USB Network POD. The POD simply plugs into the USB port of any PC or lap top. Install our voice logging software one time and play downloaded media on any lap top or home PC. Or play calls at remote PCs over your network. The idea of the Secure Play POD is you control who has the box, so you control who listens to and reviews conversations. The information is not just “available” to anyone over the network like it is with other voice loggers.**
- 5. At the master box, make a standard (44K) wave file of the conversations ACTUALLY listened to. Save that .wav file in a folder labeled wave on the (C): hard drive, and play that “public” file on any computer anywhere!! Our application gives you the “buttons” to make the wave file.**
- 6. Make that wave file playable in any computer or any CD player anywhere. Simply download that file to a blank CD, DVD or even cassette. RPT supplies the cables for you to connect a standard cassette player for wave file downloads. How much easier can you get?**
- 7. AUTOMATICALLY backs up the SCL data (.TAD) files to blank**

media in the provided DVD-R/CD-R drive. Cost: 30 Cents a day for PERMANENT storage of 24 hours of 9 channels of recording to a blank 700 Mb CD. Or try CD-RWs. Or use the 4.7 Gb blank DVDs to back up 10 DAYS of 9 channel recording on one DVD disc! Ask your sales rep where to buy blank 4.7 Gb DVD's real cheap!

8. The SCL8900 records continuously 24 hrs a day/7 days a week. Not VOX or voice operated!! The voice data is written directly to the hard drive using 50 Mb per 24 hours per channel. So, 50 Mb times 9 channels = 450 Mb every 24 hours. A CDR holds 700 Mb. So there is your backup, forever! Easily provide proof of non-event because we are recording everything. Vox systems miss calls, period.
9. Play back last month's CD, or DVD. Put your downloaded media in the DVD-R/CD-R drive, click on playback on the SCL application, select the DVD-R/CD-R drive, and select your search method! Gone are slow tape and magneto-optic backups. 5 mouse clicks and you have audio from the CD! No more interrupting the entire recording process to locate and play calls!
10. The ISA cards for the voice recording to the hard drive and the SCL program are all designed, manufactured and serviced at RPT's factory in Bristol. The same people and factory that brought the wildly successful 7870 Reel to Reel to the voice logging industry. Dozens of other loggers use "voice boards" from companies like Dialogic, etc. and just write a "little windows application". They haven't a clue, nor been in court to testify as an expert witness, about the inter-designs of a logger and the conversations they record.
